- Is composed of 1 representative from each school's governing board (Elementary and High School) and 1 representative of the advisory committee on services for handicapped students and students with social maladjustments or learning disabilities.
- Ensures communication between their GB and the Parents' Committee.
- Promotes parents' participation in the activities of the school board
- Designates parents who shall take part in the various committees established by the school board

- Purpose: Students are completing a mystery unit and will engage in an escape-room style challenge as a culmination activity.
- Schedule: Depart LRHS at 12:30 PM, return at 7:30 PM. Families will oversee pick-up at the school.
- Transportation: Bus
- Supervision: Five teachers (ratio of 1:6 as per Escaparium requirements)
- Costs: \$51.38 per student for entry; bus cost \$786.61. Fees will be fully covered by the Inspiring School measure, so the trip is free for students.

### **Cross-Country Event – Secondary Students**

- Date: Thursday, October 9, 2025
- Location: Parc Saint-Jean Bosco, Joliette
- Supervisor: Ms. Laura McTavish (with Mr. Cass joining if more than 20 students participate)
- Details: Students will participate in a cross-country race. Registration is \$13.60 per student, to be covered by the student. Families will remain on-site throughout the event. Transportation is the responsibility of the families. The school will cover Ms. McTavish's substitution.

- Dates: Thursday, October 2 Friday, October 3, 2025
- Purpose: Students will organize activities for the LRHS student body in a retreat format.
- Supervision: Daniel Johnson from PSD will attend.
- Schedule: Depart Thursday, return Friday at 12:30 PM
- Costs: Bus and meals covered through the leadership grant from last year. Substitution for Thursday will be covered by the school. The trip is free for students.
