Dear Families,

Please see below for some important information before we leave for the March break.

Office Hours: Please note that our offices will be closed from Monday, March 2nd, 2026, to Friday, March 6th, 2026. We will be available again as of Monday, March 9th, 2026, at 8:00 am. Please note that Monday, March 9th, 2026, is a pedagogical day for all students. Regular classes will resume on Tuesday, March 10th, 2026, and it will be Day 5. We wish all of your families a wonderful March Break.

Team Uniform Return and Flag Football Practices: For all students who participated in an RSEQ sport, it is time to return your team uniforms for Basketball, Futsal, and Volleyball. Please make sure to bring your uniform back to Ms. Charlotte as soon as possible. Flag Football practices will begin indoors right after March Break and will move outdoors as soon as the weather permits. Games will begin in early April 2026 and continue throughout the month of May 2026. Practice schedules will be confirmed during our first week back from the break.

Course Selection Process 2026-2027: On Friday, February 20th, 2026, you received your child's report card, and you had the opportunity to meet with teachers on Thursday, February 26th, 2026. During the course of this week, we sent letters to the honor roll students. Congratulations to all students who achieved a Term 2 average of 85% or higher. Throughout the day today, at-risk students will receive an email from Mr. Gordon, Vice-Principal, containing important information. Through the Mozaik Parent Portal if you are using a computer or laptop, or through the mobile application Clic-École, you will receive your child's course selection for the 2026-2027 school year. The deadline to complete this process is Friday, March 13th, 2026. Please note the following important points:

- All students were preliminarily placed based on a summary of their Term 1 and Term 2 grades.
- Preliminary placement for Secondary 1 and 2 students followed the promotion policy of 26 credits, while Secondary 3 and 4 students were placed using the promotion-by-subject approach. [Promotion policies](#) for all levels can be found on the school website.
- Final placement will occur in June 2026, following the completion of Term 3 and all final exams. Adjustments will be made as needed.

Summer School: Summer school will be offered for all high schools within the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board. More information will follow, as details are not yet finalized. As we enter Term 3, this is an important reminder that:

- Summer school might not be offered for all classes and all levels.
- Students should focus on maintaining strong academic performance during the school year to avoid repeating a course or grade level.
- Summer school is often required in Secondary 4 and 5 for students who do not meet Ministry graduation requirements.
- With promotion by subject now applying to all Secondary 3 and 4 students, passing all courses is increasingly essential to avoid being at risk for delayed graduation.
- Ministry exams in Secondary 4 and 5 are worth 50% of the final grade.

Hard work and perseverance remain crucial.
