Dear families,

As the end of the school year approaches, we would like to express our appreciation for your ongoing support and collaboration. It is essential for us to ensure a safe and respectful environment for all students and staff at Laurentian Regional High School. We would also like to take this opportunity to remind everyone of the importance of civility in all interactions. In the past, there have been instances in some of our school board's schools where inappropriate, unsanctioned end-of-year activities led to incidents of bullying, violence, and disrespect towards the school's staff and facilities. In some cases, these incidents led to unsafe situations that put the security of staff and students at risk. In addition, social media platforms are often advertising challenges that could be very detrimental to the well-being of our students and the security of our schools. We want to remind all students and families that a respectful behaviour is always expected, and that such activities/challenges will not be tolerated.

We would also like to make families aware of a viral end-of-year game currently circulating among members of the Class of 2026, which also has been played before, commonly referred to as "Senior Assassin." This game uses a mobile application that allows players to locate and "target" one another, with the goal of "eliminating" their target using water guns. While some water guns are clearly identifiable as toys, others closely resemble real firearms and may only be distinguished by a small orange tip that can be easily removed or modified. If a member of the public is unable to immediately identify the object as a toy, this activity may result in emergency calls to police and trigger serious law-enforcement responses. For safety reasons, this game is strictly prohibited on school property and on school buses. This message is shared to reinforce vigilance and ensure the safety of all students, staff, and community members.

The school's [Code of Conduct](#), under the umbrella of the [Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board's Policy on Safe, Caring Schools and Centres](#), will remain in effect until the end of the year. We kindly ask for your assistance in emphasizing the importance of following these guidelines with your child. Failure to adhere to the Code of Conduct or participation in any activities that the school considers unsafe will result in severe consequences. These consequences can include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Suspension from school (the end of the current school year or the beginning of the following school year)
- Possibility of writing final exams in a different school
- Exclusion from prom (June)
- Police intervention
- Meeting at the head office
- Exclusion from end of year activities if any
- Possible exclusion from field trips and school activities for the current or following school year

Please note that the school board will not be held responsible for any costs incurred or losses caused by the above-mentioned consequences. We appreciate your cooperation in creating a positive and safe environment for everyone at Laurentian Regional High School. Together, we can ensure that the end of the year is a time for celebration and mutual respect.
