Dear families,

Welcome, or welcome back to LRHS! We hope that all of you will have a wonderful summer before you get ready for the adventure of high school. Please see below for reminders and important information on the upcoming year.

Orientation Session for Students: LRHS will offer orientation sessions for our Secondary 1 cohort on Tuesday, August 25th, 2026, Wednesday, August 26th, 2026, and Thursday, August 27th, 2026. During these sessions, your child will have the opportunity to participate in an in-person orientation at the school. While students have a chance to tour the school and become familiar with the building, parents will have the opportunity to receive information about the school and order clothing from our school store. During these orientation sessions, students will see a sample Grade 7 schedule, walk around, explore, and locate classrooms. We also strongly encourage Secondary 1 students to bring their school supplies on orientation day. This will help reduce stress the first time they take the bus to high school, as they will have direct access to their lockers. The Secondary 1 orientation sessions will last approximately one and a half hours. All students and families are asked to sign up for the session of their choice. Code of Conduct: We would like to inform you that several updates are being made to the LRHS Code of Conduct. These changes are currently being finalized and will be available for consultation on our [school website](#) starting Monday, July 6th, 2026. At the beginning of the 2026-2027 school year, all families are going to be asked to sign a document stating they have read and understood the Code of Conduct. Beginning this fall, we will be applying the dress code regulations as approved by the Governing Board with greater consistency and clarity. The goal is to help students understand the importance of dressing appropriately for different contexts, including academic settings. This is part of our broader mission to prepare students for life beyond school, including the workplace. In alignment with new provincial directives, all students will be required to keep their cell phones and electronic devices in their lockers from 8:40 am to 3:20 pm. These devices must not be used or visible at any time during the school day, including recess and lunch. Students in Secondary 3, 4, and 5 who have permission to leave school grounds at lunch will also be expected to leave their devices in their lockers during that time. Failure to comply will result in consequences as outlined in the updated Code of Conduct.
