Final Report Cards: Please note that all report cards are accessible on Clic École. If you have any questions on how to access the Clic École, please communicate with Ms. Lydia Guenette at 450-562-8571 extension 8405. All important phone calls about placement for the 2026-2027 school year, summer enrichment for secondary 1-2 and summer school for secondary 3, 4 and 5 have been made. Furthermore, an email will be sent to all families next week for which their child is on the honor roll for the final term of the year. As a reminder, for secondary 4 and 5 students, the official grades still need to be issued by the Ministry in some subjects. We are expecting these grades to be available on Tuesday July 7th, 2026. Should the grades be available earlier, the school will contact students and let them know if summer school is needed. Online Consultation of Academic Record: All secondary 4 and 5 students will be able to access their academic record online with the Ministry as of Tuesday July 7th, 2026. Code of Conduct: We would like to inform you that several updates are being made to the LRHS Code of Conduct. These changes are currently being finalized and will be available for consultation on our [school website](#) starting Monday, July 6th, 2026. At the beginning of the 2026-2027 school year, all families are going to be asked to sign a document stating they have read and understood the Code of Conduct. Beginning this fall, we will be applying the dress code regulations as approved by the Governing Board with greater consistency and clarity. The goal is to help students understand the importance of dressing appropriately for different contexts, including academic settings. This is part of our broader mission to prepare students for life beyond school, including the workplace. In alignment with new provincial directives, all students will be required to keep their cell phones and electronic devices in their lockers from 8:40 am to 3:20 pm. These devices must not be used or visible at any time during the school day, including recess and lunch. Students in Secondary 3, 4, and 5 who have permission to leave school grounds at lunch will also be expected to leave their devices in their lockers during that time.
