Forms: On Monday August 31st, 2026, students received important forms that need to be signed by parents and returned to school as soon as possible. All forms are in an envelope. Please make sure to take the time to go over these forms, fill them out and sign them accordingly. If not done so already, these forms need to be returned to the school as soon as possible.

Annual General Assembly and Curriculum Night: Our Annual General Assembly for parents will take place on Thursday, September 17, 2026, at 6:00 pm. This event will be combined with Curriculum Night. A separate email was sent this morning containing all the necessary information. We look forward to seeing you on that evening.

Reminder on School Attendance and Retake Session: Regular attendance is particularly important for students. The material being taught, evaluations, and project or assignment deadlines are all significantly affected when a student misses' school. Families are asked to report all absences to the school and to keep them to a minimum. It is also important to note that one of the strongest indicators of student success is regular attendance. Because of our rotating schedule, it can be challenging for students to catch up on what they have missed. For this reason, the school has designated a specific day for students to complete any evaluations or tests they have missed due to an absence. Every Thursday at lunchtime starting on Thursday September 24th, 2026, there will be a test or evaluation retake session. Teachers may require that a missed test or evaluation be completed during this time. If your child is required to attend, you will receive an email from the teacher. Please note that if a teacher schedules your child for a lunch retake session, it cannot be rescheduled to another day. Only one retake opportunity will be granted, and it will take place on the Thursday following your child's absence.

Official Attestation Day: All families will receive a document sent by the head office regarding the official attestation of attendance. On Wednesday September 30th, 2026, it will be attestation day. This is when we confirm the number of students in our school. Presence at school is essential every day, but most particularly on that day. Students that are absent on this day will need to bring a document home for parents to sign to confirm that they are students of LRHS (Laurentian Regional High School). Please make sure that your child is present at school on that day. Again, please ensure that your child is present on that day.

Truth and Reconciliation Day: Both the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day will be underlined on Wednesday September 30th, 2026, in school. On that day, we encourage all staff and students to wear orange to honor the thousands of Survivors of residential schools. Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family, and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters." The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.
